A specific time for public comment is set aside at each board meeting. This gives the public an opportunity to address the board and express opinions or ask questions about school district matters, and reserves the rest of the meeting for uninterrupted deliberation and action.

Public comment can be provided in a variety of ways, including in-person and virtually, or via an online submission form, voicemail, email or postal mail.

Board elections are held on the third Tuesday in May each year, in conjunction with the annual budget vote.
