TEACHERS of TOMORROW Recruitment Incentive Program

Newly hired teachers selected may receive a \$3,400 recruitment incentive award each year up to a maximum of four years (subject to APPR rating requirements listed below and Teachers of Tomorrow grant funding). In the event there are more applicants than available funding, eligible applicants will be selected on a first come-first served basis.

To be eligible, a teacher must:

- Apply as a first-time employee to the City School District of Albany, with an initial
 probationary hire date between Aug. 31, 2017 and Aug. 31, 2018. Individuals that
 have previously worked for the district in any capacity or at any time in the past
 other than the hiring dates listed above are not eligible for this program.
- Hold an initial, transitional, provisional, permanent or professional New York teaching certificate in one of the following shortage areas as a full-time employee: math, technology, family and consumer sciences (FACS), English as a new language (ENL), cosmetology, special education grades 7-12, literacy 7-12 or science.
- Not have received an award from any other Teachers of Tomorrow category in the same year.
- Upon approval, teachers will be required to sign and submit a service agreement contract agreeing to teach one full year in the City School District of Albany in one of the shortage areas listed above.
- Going forward, individuals must reapply for each subsequent year of the incentive program, and must maintain and effective of highly effective APPR rating to remain eligible.
